Such easy piecing! If you've completed our Grade One class, this is for you! Every block is sewn the same, but with varying fabrics, colours and values. With our teacher's guidance you will learn how to choose fabric values, how to be more precise in your piecing, and how to press correctly. You'll want to revisit your stash after you've done this one! Grade 1 is a prerequisite. Pattern required. Kits available in many colour choices. Size varies in 12" increments. Blocks are 12 ½" x 12 ½" unfinished.

You'll need a simple zig zag machine, some polyester thread, and you're set to dive into the world of "all things rope". As a bonus, our instructor has provided quick notes on how to make the accompanying baby blanket (ours is flannel and fireside!) and co-ordinating burp pads!

Consistency in your seams is essential to make all of these varying sized blocks fit together nicely. This quilt represents a town square with the feature block in the center followed by six rounds of varying blocks with beginner to intermediate techniques. This class is a lecture, machines not required in class. Kit and pattern purchase required. Three rulers are recommended. Fabrics are the individual’s choice.

Beginner Scan n Cut

If you have purchased your Scan N Cut from Rumpled Quilt Skins and would like a refresher course on how to prep your fabric, and manipulate and organize your cut files, this class is for you. Our instructor is well-versed with everything that may go awry in preparing your cuts for a quilt, and knows how to prevent any of the hazards of cutting. This particular project is a three-fold: Beginner machine appliqué, beginner Scan N Cut, and beginner machine embroidery appliqué in the hoop. Look for the other two classes found in this newsletter. Branching Out Machine Embroidery

This project involves some of the most challenging cuts we've ever made! The good thing is – all they require is the proper prep work! Branching Out is five separate hoopings, placed precisely. While anyone is welcome to join, it is almost impossible to trim manually with scissors... a Scan N Cut is recommended. Each tree has a decorative fill to avoid the need for a motif line or blanket stitch on the outside of the intricate branches and deer. We think you'll be beaming at the knowledge and skill you've acquired when you've done this class! **Knowledge of your Scan N Cut is essential. Beginner scan n Cut is recommended. Finished size: 12' x 36". Kits available. Pattern required.**

Bringing Home the Tree

Large gentle curves and lots of straight lines mean that this wall hanging will be so much fun to work on! What a great place to try out some of your decorative stitches and put your pivoting skills to the test. We're encouraged by the texture of the flannel, wool felt and cotton fabrics in the kit – so easy to hide any little burps you might have along the way. Finished Size: 43" x 51 ½".

Grade 3 Beginner Appliqué is a prerequisite. Pattern required. Kits available.

There is so much free information out there for you to teach yourself to quilt, but we believe in the power of feedback. Learn from scratch how to handle your fabric, the right way to cut, sew, press and sew scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. Incorporate that knowledge to create half square triangles, rail fences and nine patches. The beauty of this is the encouraging guidance you receive, as you make samples of each step of the way. This is not a project class – nothing to finish when you get home, just a wealth of knowledge for what you are doing right, and what you could do to become better. **This class is a prerequisite for Grade 1.** Pattern required. Kits available.

Grade 1: Beginner Quilting

Is this the year you are ready to take on a new hobby? Are you new to quilting or desperate for a refresher? Then this is the class for you. In this four-session class you will learn to use your rotary cutter and ruler, master a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and proper pressing techniques. You'll become skilled in rail fence, nine patch, half square triangles, learn basic piecing. Your instruction will include sashings, borders, binding, how to use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot, walking foot, and all the required tools of quilting. **Essential Quilting Foundation Skills** is a prerequisite for this class. . Finished size 40" x 40" . Pattern required. Kits available.

Grade 2: Log Cabin

If you've taken Grade 1, the next advancing class is our Grade 2 Log Cabin. In this project, you learn the importance of fabric values, power sewing, accuracy and squaring up. The size of quilt is your choice from 28" x 28" to king size. While every block is exactly the same, one of the benefits of a log cabin is the wide range of setting options to vary how the quilt looks. **Grade 1 is a prerequisite.** Book required. Kits available.

Grade 3: Beginner Appliqué

Not sure how you feel about appliqué? Let us show you how it can be creative, rewarding! Adding the dimension of appliqué to your fabrics can be daunting without some guidance and stitch understanding. Take this beginner class to build a base of knowledge about the character of appliqué and discover the tricks of how to achieve smooth corners, great coverage and unique edges. Take this opportunity to learn another ability of your machine when combined with beautiful threads and your imagination. Finished Size approximately 18" x 18". Pattern required. Kits available. Other quilting classes are not required as a prerequisite.

Grade 7: Beginner Paper Piecing

A beginner project awaits those of you who are new to paper piecing or those who would like a refresher course. Let us help you get started on the right track to this technique that allows you to achieve exact sharp points. Finished Size: Placemat: 14 ½" x 20", Table Runner 16" x 38 ½". Pattern required. Kits available. This class is a prerequisite for all other paper piecing classes.

Grade 8: Quilting with a Walking foot “Floor Boards”

New quilters are always daunted by the quilting required to make the fabric and batting all come together. Take this class to learn how effective your walking foot can be, and how it negates the need for free motion quilting. This table runner shows off your piecing skills with two simple blocks, then lets you continue to add some “embossing” to embellish its appearance. Grade 1 is a prerequisite. Pattern required. Kits available.

Grade 9: Beginner Free Motion Quilting

Learning the art of free motion quilting is the another step in taking ownership of your quilt! Starting with no knowledge is perfect as you accumulate skills and a plethora of techniques for stabilizing and filling each specific area in your sampler table runner. This is a manageable size which allows you to try out various types of free motion movements, and enables you to get it done. Learn how to do circles, leaves, loops, and straight line fills. Book required.

This class is a prerequisite for other free motion classes.

Grade 12: Ruler Work Bed Runner

Choosing the fabrics, selecting the pattern and constructing the top are all typical steps of making a quilt. The final art of quilting through the layers adds an embossing that brings it all to life. With so many choices to make for how to quilt your project, it is always an easy pick to use a ruler foot and a free-motion ruler to create straight lines, perfectly positioned across the blocks, down the sashing and out to the borders. Create your own journal on fabric of varying quilting methods for how to fill the shapes in the blocks. This bed runner project will morph into a sampler of so many ideas for your ruler work. Finished size: 36" x 76". Book required.

Grade 9 Beginner Free Motion is a recommended prerequisite.

Most times you have a bit of fabric left over and you wonder what to do with it... this is the answer! Take a bit of feature fabric, the smallest amount of seven co-ordinates, add a background to easily make this runner. So versatile! While the cuts are precise, the sewing is easy. Be consistent in your $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams and you'll get in the groove of how this runner is made. Need a gift for a friend? What to dress up an entryway? Wish you had a way of gussying up the dining room table? We think this straight-line sewing runner will become one of your "go-to" patterns to reduce your stash in a flash. Grade 1 is a prerequisite. Finished Size: 18" x 54 $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Pattern required. Limited kits available.
